HGR Industrial Surplus 50cc Kid Karts (WKA), age 5 to 7

Participation class per WKA rules to allow children to learn to race in a friendly, fun environment.

No season points. Participation trophies to each kid karter.

Parents of participants to agree as a group before each race whether restrictors should be used for the day's kid karters.

Tow Pro Trailers Briggs Junior Sportsman 1, age 8 to 12

Wt. 265lbs for either

WKA Gold Cup spec Raptor with purple plate (alcohol), or

CKRA "Claimer" spec Animal black plate .250(gas)

WKA Gold Cup bodywork rules plus the following:

Nose cone mandatory and may exceed 14" height if driver passes vision test per club rules.

Side panels mandatory

Driver fairing disallowed

CKRA Animal claimer rules apply, see separate regulations.

Federico Tire 2 Cycle Jr Sportsman, age 8 to 12

CADET JR Sportsman (80cc Cadet) per WKA class rules

Engine: Comer K-80

Fuel: Gas and Oil

Wt. 225 lb.

KART: Overall MAX. Length 72", Wheelbase 35" Min. and 41" max.

YAMAHA JR Sportsman per WKA class rules

Engine: Yamaha KT100S, only heads with OEM casting "Yamaha" and cylinders with Y3, Y4 or 787 are legal

Fuel: Gas and Oil

Wt. 250 lb.

Carburetor: Walbro WA55B or HPV1 with WA55B manifold

Tires open

If needed, we will make adjustments to class specs in the interest of maintaining equality.

Alpine Valley Briggs Restricted Junior, age 12 to 15

Wt. 325lbs for WKA Gold Cup spec stock Raptor unrestrictor(alcohol)

Wt. 305lbs for CKRA "Claimer" spec Animal with Horstman/Rocketech Gold restrictor (size TBA)(gas)

Wt. 325lbs for WKA Gold Cup spec stock Animal w/.575 black restrictor (alcohol)

Gold Cup bodywork rules apply to all engine choices

CKRA Animal claimer rules apply to CKRA spec Animals, see separate regulations.

Saturn of Mentor Junior Supercan, age 12 to 15

310 lb, YAM and ARC (RLV, SSX-V)

Open engine clutch, clutch is mandatory, NO axle clutches

Cometic Gasket Senior Animal, 15 and up

345lbs. on gas

390lbs. on alcohol - maximum kart weight for alcohol is 200lbs.

CKRA spec Animal Tech Rules apply to both gas and alcohol motors

CIK or 4 Cycle Gold Cup bodywork is permitted.

Rear bumper lower crossbar per figure 209.3.5 is required on all karts.

Max width 55 1/8"

CKRA Animal claimer rules apply, see separate regulations.

American Power Sports Senior Sportsman (Supercan), age 15 and up

345 lb YAM and ARC (RLV, SSX-V)

350 lb YAM with old style cylinder (RLV, SSX-V)

385 lb YAM and ARC with RLV SBX muffler "can on a stick" Spec 100)

400 lb Foreign piston port with RLV SBX muffler "can on a stick" (PV92, P50, P51, K71, HPV, T50, RK100, PP100)

Header length 11" to 12", with SBX muffler, measured to piston

Max kart weight 190 lb Spec 100, and 205 lb foreign piston ports

Open engine clutch, clutch is mandatory, NO axle clutches

If needed, we will make adjustments to class specs in the interest of maintaining equality

Novice Group, 8 to 12

(instructional)

This group will be run on an as-needed basis to provide a place for new participants to learn to race without the hazard of running with seasoned veterans. The group will be comprised of 2 Cycle Jr Sportsman Comers and Yamahas, and 4 Cycle Jr. Sportsman Raptors and Animals. Finishing position will be as if they finished at the tail end of the appropriate class. For example, if there were 6 2 Cycle Jr Sportsmen in the 2 Cycle Jr Sportsmen class, the highest finishing 2 Cycle Jr Sportman in the Novice Group would receive 7th place points for the day. And so on with any other 2 Cycle Jr Sportsman. The same practice would apply to the 4 Cycle Jr Sportsman Raptors and Animals. The intent of this group is to provide a less intense place to learn how to drive and race.

Please get a WKA rulebook and become familiar with the rules.

We will be following WKA rules with exceptions as noted.

Open tires for all classes, 5" or 6" dia rims allowed for all classes.

2 cycle intake silencer is required (ref. section 551)

4 cycle muffler is required (ref section 701.2)

If a driver will reach the age to be eligible for the next age group, either 8-12 or 12-15, within the regularly scheduled CKRA season; they may move up at the beginning of the season with administration approval. Drivers may not move up early to the senior classes.
